Software version 5.8.4.3 is a recommended upgrade for the Hughes 9202 terminal. Many of these terminals are over 10 years old and some could encounter the GPS roll over issue by the year 2029 – see below.

Release Notes for 5.8.4.3

Enhancements

- The new release corrects the date when the GPS week rolls over. Intrinsic to the design of the GPS system, the broadcast date rolls over every 1024 weeks, which causes the GPS chip to report the wrong date when it is 19.7 years old, preventing the UT from registering on the BGAN system.
- Updates the default satellite constellation information to include IOE and remove MEAS.
- Fix the Support page to allow download of log files when using the current generation of browsers.
